- £110,000 : State of the art NavX machine for Electrophysiology to better identify and treat heart rhythm disorders
- £90,000 : Portable Echocardiograph Machine and Transoesophageal Probe
- £35,000 : to start the use of Drug Eluting Stents
- £25,000 : Treadmill for Exercise Testing in Coronary Care Unit
- £30,000 : Sophisticated Gas Analysis Exercise Equipment for use in heart failure and preoperative patients
- £105,000 : To enable 3 of our Registrars to take a year out of programme for research
- £15,000 : Special Drain equipment for rapid healing of problem chest wounds
- £10,000 : Research on Coronary Risk factors
- £10,000 : Research on heart failure testing
- £5,000 : Annual Bursary (Scholarship) for a Durham/Stockton Medical Student year of research
- £10,000 : Minimally invasive vein harvesting equipment (for Coronary Artery By Pass Grafting)
- £50,000 Pump priming the percutaneous aortic valve replacement programme
